



Medication Aide / Tech

This course covers the basic preparation for administration of medications by unlicensed persons in a variety of settings.

The course is designed to prepare the student to assume the role and responsibilities of the Medication Aide and to prepare the student to take the competency testing required for listing as a Medication Aide in the State of North Carolina.

***Pre-Requisites for Med Aide: A high school diploma or equivalent. NA-I. No pre-requisites for Med Tech.*

*Requirement: Students must complete **all classes (20 hours—Med Tech and 24 hours—Med Aide)** in order to successfully complete the course.*

4 Easy Ways to Register for Classes

1 Online

- GO to **continue.waketech.edu** and click on "CE Online Registration"
- SEARCH for classes using a course title, course number, start or end dates, location, or instructor's last name,

4 In Person

- Registration payments in person may be made with personal check, money order, or credit card (MasterCard or Visa). Checks and money orders should be made payable to Wake Technical Community College.
- Cash payments are accepted only at Main, Northern Wake, and Western Wake campuses when cashier services are available.
- Evening or weekend registrations may be deposited in the drop box located at the cashier's window. Do not include cash with drop box registrations.
- Classes fill quickly; if you choose to register on the first day of class, be aware that seats may not be available. Early registration is encouraged.
- You can register at other Campuses and Community School Sites ONLY if there are still seats available. Early registration is encouraged. No cash payment is accepted at this sites.
