Senior Care Pharmacy sold to Guardian

A Northwestside pharmacy that caters to long-term care patients has been sold to Guardian Pharmacy LLC and two local partners.

Guardian said it bought Senior Care Pharmacy at 6530 Corporate Drive this week with Zionsville businessmen Steve Piepenbrink and Brian Hardesty and started operating it under the name Guardian Pharmacy of Indiana.

The 5,000-square-foot pharmacy has 13 employees, including some who worked for Senior Care.

The pharmacy's niche is supplying medications and other medical supplies to long-term care and group homes and assisted living and skilled nursing facilities throughout the state. Atlanta-based Guardian is one of the largest long-term care pharmacy companies in the country.

Piepenbrink is president of the pharmacy and a co-owner with Hardesty.
